

**Minimize the Effects of Sequestration on National Security  
(15: National Security)  
Resolution 25-13**

**WHEREAS**, the Budget Control Act of 2011 (“BCA”) created a Joint Select Committee on Deficit Reduction (“JSCDR”) and further provided that certain across-the-board spending cuts divided equally between defense and non-defense spending would be automatically implemented if the JSCDR did not produce legislation to significantly reduce the federal deficit; and

**WHEREAS**, the JSCDR failed to produce such legislation and the across-the-board spending cuts required by the BCA (known as “Sequestration”) have been and are being implemented by the various Departments of the Federal Government; and

**WHEREAS**, across-the-board cuts do not translate into proportional cuts because the Reserve Component budgets are smaller which will result in program closures; and

**WHEREAS**, sequestration has been applied and may be applied in the future to all programs in the Department of Defense and the Department of Homeland Security without regard to their effect on mission-critical areas such as force deployment, readiness and training, resulting in negative impacts to our Nation’s military and homeland security forces; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Charter of ROA provides that the purpose of the association is to support and promote the development and execution of a military policy for the United States that will provide adequate national security; and

**WHEREAS**, ROA believes the Department of Defense and the Department of Homeland Security should avoid sequestration and provide adequate funding to mission-critical programs such as force deployment, readiness, and training;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that ROA, d.b.a. Reserve Organization of America, urges Congress to take measures to oppose sequestration for the purpose of ensuring the national security of the United States.
