ROA Executive Director Jeff Phillips interviews Scott Felder on the history of the case

ROA, its members, and legal partners were instrumental in *Feliciano v. Department of Transportation* case, decided April 30, 2025, where the U.S. Supreme Court expanded the rights of federal employees who serve in the military reserves.

The case centers on 5 U.S.C. § 5538, which provides differential pay to federal civilian employees called to active duty “during a war or national emergency.”


