Lieutenant Colonel Peter W. Powell Jr is a native of Long Beach, California and enlisted in the Army Reserve in 1997, as a Personnel Information Management Specialist while assigned to the 376th Personnel Service Battalion. He earned his Commission from the University of California, Riverside ROTC in 2001. LTC Powell is a graduate of the Quartermaster Officer Basic Course, Combined Logistics Captain Career Course, Command and General Staff College, and the Reserve Component National Security Course.

LTC Powell's deployments are two for OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM, first as platoon leader of a Quartermaster Company (DS) in Taji, Iraq, second as a Forward Logistics Element (FLE) Commander supporting 10th Mountain Division in Baghdad, and one deployment in support of OPERATIONS SPARTAN SHIELD in Camp Arifjan, Kuwait as the Deputy G-3 for the 1st Theater Sustainment Command (TSC) Forward.
