The Reserve Officers Association of the United States, now known as the Reserve Organization of America, to reflect its all-ranks membership, was founded during the difficult years after the first world war. ROA continues to serve the Guard and Reserve components in an era where the need is greater than ever before.

- Sole MSO participating in the battlefield toxicity (“burn pits”) PACT Act 24/7 Capitol Steps vigil, winning passage into law.
- TRICARE Reserve Select extended for all Reserve Component federal employees who were previously barred from TRS.
- ROA amicus brief helps gain USAR Capt. Le Roy Torres a Supreme Court burn pits hearing; a second ROA amicus brief helps win the case.
- DoD approves DD-214-1 separation of service document for RC service.
- Secured passage of Deborah Sampson Act, landmark legislation to help ensure women veterans receive service-earned VA health care and benefits.
- Authorized and appropriated Public Health Service Ready Reserve.
- President executive order extended Title 32 orders for RC troops serving Covid-19 support ensured educational benefits after ROA intervention.
- Established early age Reserve retirement for contingency orders as early as age 50.
- Combatant Command (12304b) orders given GI Bill, medical, pay differential, and high deployment allowance – previously did not include benefits.
- DoD’s 16<sup>th</sup> year service limit overturned on when servicemembers could transfer Post 9-11/GI Bill benefits to family members.
- VA home loan program parity given to the Reserve Components.
- Military Student Identifier now includes Reserve Component families to help with contingency challenges and other long-term orders.
- Extended the option of lump sum retirement pay to National Guard and Reserve members and provide a continuation bonus with new Blended Retirement System.
- ROA defeats USAF plans to scrap A-10 to fund “fast movers” and wins increased funding for Warthog upkeep.
- HMMWV Ambulances replaced with \$120M in additional funding to replace 100% (412) of the existing ambulance fleet.
- TRICARE coverage extended from 90 to 180 days for Reserve Component members and their families prior to mobilization.
- Inactive duty days limit increased from 60 to 130 days.
- Milestone Reserve Forces Bill of Rights and Vitalization Act established a Selected Reserve in each service.
- Armed Forces Reserve Act passed to establish the Ready Reserve.
- Ensured full commissary and exchange privileges for reservists not on duty.
- Overseas military voting extended to 45 days prior to an election and converted absentee ballot applications to electronic version.
